Marlboro County High School Senior Scholarships Application

Four \$750 scholarships are available to high school seniors to pay for tuition and books in their freshman year of either a two-year or four-year college or university:

Nan Fleming Scholarship

In honor Marlboro County School District Board Member Emeritus, Ms. Nan Fleming, this scholarship will be awarded to a deserving high school senior who demonstrates good character, citizenship, and service to his or her community. Nan Fleming, a tireless advocate for children and the marginalized, served in various capacities in the Marlboro community for many years. Her selfless work embodies the Marlboro County School District's theme "I love you, I care for you, and I am here for you".

#345 Scholarship

Marlboro County School District's theme is #345: I love you (3 words), I care about you (4 words), and I am here for you (5 words). These words communicate commitment to both students and community.

Marlboro County School District's Superintendent Dr. Gregory McCord believes that a quality education is critical to a student's future success and is committed to providing a solid foundation for learning.

Students applying must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Completed scholarship application
- Minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher
- An official high school transcript
- Participation in extracurricular activities (sports, clubs, band, etc.)
- Two (2) letters of recommendations from a Marlboro County School District employee and a community member
- 250-500-word double-spaced typed essay titled, "**What does it mean to me to be a community servant?**"

The application process begins February 1st of the graduating year and will end March 31st of the graduating year. The scholarship packet is to be submitted to the high school guidance counselor by March 31, 2021. Winners will be selected, notified, and announced at the May board meeting.

Scholarship payments will be made payable to the college or university upon receiving a letter of acceptance and sent to the college or university the recipient will be attending in the fall semester after graduation.
