Dear Parents or Guardians:

Students who have failed one or more courses during the 2019 – 2020 school year due to attendance or academics may recover these classes beginning on June 15, 2020 and continuing through July 9, 2020. The cost for each course is \$40.00. Summer school attendance and credit recovery will meet virtually Monday – Thursday from 8:00 A.M. – 12:00 P.M.

Open enrollment will be held on June 10 – 11, 2020 at MCHS. Students who fail to register during these dates may continue to enroll throughout the program provided there is ample time remaining to complete the desired course/seat time.

Students who have failed a core course academically in Math, English, Science, Social Studies, Computer Applications, IBA, Spanish, or French with a grade of 50 – 59 will be eligible to enroll.

Registration fees and attendance does not guarantee the student will recover credit. Each student must maintain an average of 60 or higher and successfully complete at least 60% of the assignments by the last day of class to recover credit. Courses recovered will be credited on the student's transcript, but the student will only receive a pass or fail coding regardless of the actual average.

Students who enroll must have prior approval from their school counselor and provide proof of a failing grade of 50 – 59. Students who fail a course with a grade below 50 **ARE NOT** eligible to attend the summer school credit recovery program.
